In this video you will learn how to load a tenement map, move around the map (pan), change the map scale and obtain tenement information.

Start by loading a map by making an Enquiry.

From the top task bar menu, select Enquiry.

A menu list drops down. Select the Gazetteer/Place Name option.

A new dialogue box will open. In this example we will load a mining tenement map of Meekatharra in Western Australia.

Using the keyboard, type in Meekatharra in the open window and select the Apply button or simply press the enter key.

Select TNST Meekatharra from the list and click the Apply button or press the enter key.

A map of the Meekatharra region is loaded.

If you don't have a place name try one of the other Enquiry options such as Enquire by Tenement number.

From the top task bar menu, select Enquiry then select the Tenement option.

Type E20/742 into the Tenement ID window.

Click the Apply button and a map centred on this mining tenement is loaded.

The tenement ID information is shown near the top left hand corner of the TENGRAPH application.

To obtain further information on highlighted mining tenements select the "i..." icon near the top right corner.

Select the buttons within the open dialogue for extra information such as tenement holder details.

You can print a tenement summary report by selecting the Tenement Report button.

If you would like further tenement information click the Tenement Register button near the bottom right corner of the dialogue box.

Mineral Titles Online will open providing Tenement Register details.

Close or minimise Mineral Titles Online.

Selecting the Help button will open the TENGRAPH user manual explaining how to use the features associated with the open dialogue box.

To zoom in select the button that looks like two arrows going in opposite directions near the top right corner. The shape of your mouse cursor will change from an arrow to an open square.

Select a position on the map and hold down your left mouse button to draw a shape on the screen where you would like to zoom into.

The map display will be refreshed at a larger scale when the mouse button is released.

To Pan across the screen select the button that looks like a cross in the top right corner. Your mouse cursor will change to a cross when selected. Clicking the cross on the screen will centre the map on that position.

To get information about other objects move your mouse cursor over the Next icon near the top right corner.

Keep pressing the Next icon until the object of interest is highlighted.

Select the "i..." icon to get more information about the highlighted object. When you are finished, close the MINEDEX Site Information dialogue box.

Another way to change the scale of the map display is to select View from the top task bar menu.

Select the Zoom Out x2 option to change the scale of the map.

Granted or Live tenements are green.

Pending tenement applications have a blue pattern.
