Information required to accompany application:

- A. The original instrument evidencing the devolution (document showing sufficient evidence that the rights of the holder have devolved by operation of law), executed by all parties to the devolution together with one executed or certified copy, along with 2 copies of the application form.
- B. A brief description of the devolution
- C. Details of the participating interests held by the Devolutor(s) and subsequent participating interests of the Devoltee.
- D. Details of incoming corporation(s) and its relationship to any major corporation or group, substantial shareholding, directors, principal business activity and place of incorporation/business (where a current annual report reveals all the above information such is acceptable).
- E. Details of the incoming corporation's financial status and its ability to fund its share of the venture.
- F. Details of the technical expertise of, and available to, the incoming corporation and particulars of other current and previous involvements in petroleum exploration and development.
- G. Where devolution submitted under *Petroleum Pipelines Act 1969*, you will need to provide a completed Registration Form B2 from the Department of Land Information for the registration of new titleholders against the easements under the *Transfer of Land Act 1893* as amended.
- H. Where an incoming corporation is well known to the Department and has provided the information under B, C & D within recent times, the requirements to provide that information is not necessary.
- I. Any time constraints written into the instrument should be highlighted.
