Quarter 1 | 2017

Approvals Performance Report March Quarter 2017 (1 January – 31 March 2017)

In the March quarter 2017, 97 per cent of all applications were finalised within target timelines. Highlights include:

- 99 per cent of mineral prospecting licence applications were finalised within 65 business days;
- 97 per cent of mineral exploration Programme of Work (PoW Exploration) applications were finalised within 30 business days; and
- 100 per cent of petroleum well applications were finalised within 40 business days.

Highlights

A total of 639 Programme of Work applications were received in the March 2017 quarter compared to 416 applications in the March 2016 quarter. This is a significant increase in the number of mineral exploration applications (see figure 1). Ninety seven per cent of Programme of Work applications were finalised within target timelines.

Figure 1: Number of Mineral Exploration Programme of Work applications received each quarter from 1 January 2016 to 31 March 2017.


