COMMUNIQUE - September 2019

A summary of the Mining Rehabilitation Advisory Panel's Meeting on 25 September 2019

1. Shaft Remediation Pilot Project (Donnybrook)

The department has commenced project planning and initial consultation for a shaft remediation pilot project to address significant safety risks in a section of the Argyle Forest Block south of Donnybrook. The project is being undertaken in collaboration with the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions.

2. Strategic Workshop

A new Panel of members has been appointed to MRAP holding office for a term not exceeding three years.

A Strategic Workshop will be held in late 2019 to explore and map out priority areas for consideration, for the Mining Rehabilitation Fund and Abandoned Mines Program in the forthcoming 2 to 3 years.

3. Consistent and effective processes

The panel is working with the Department to adopt consistent and effective processes for prioritising projects under the Abandoned Mines Program, and for planning and undertaking abandoned mine projects.
