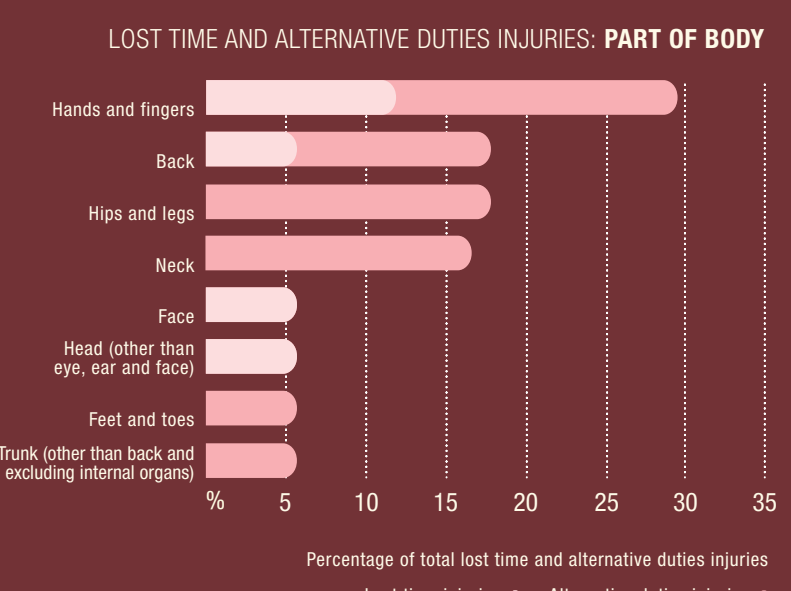
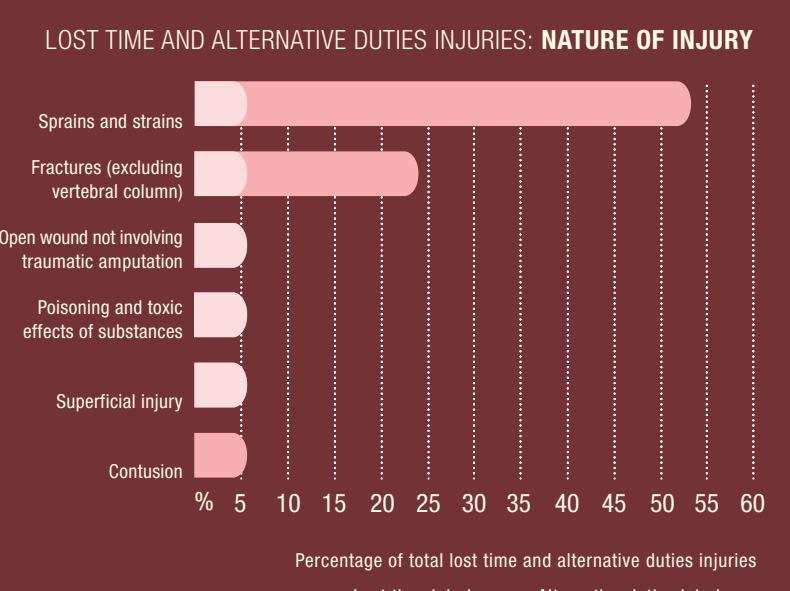
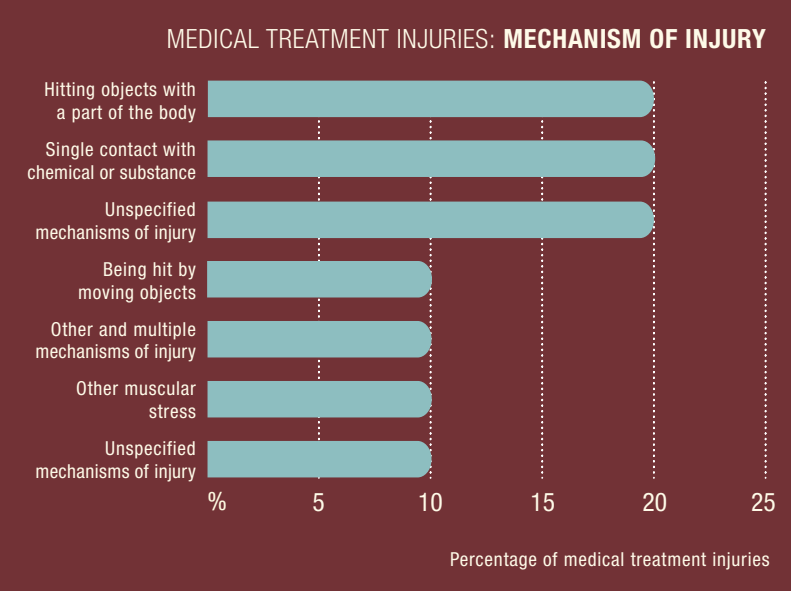
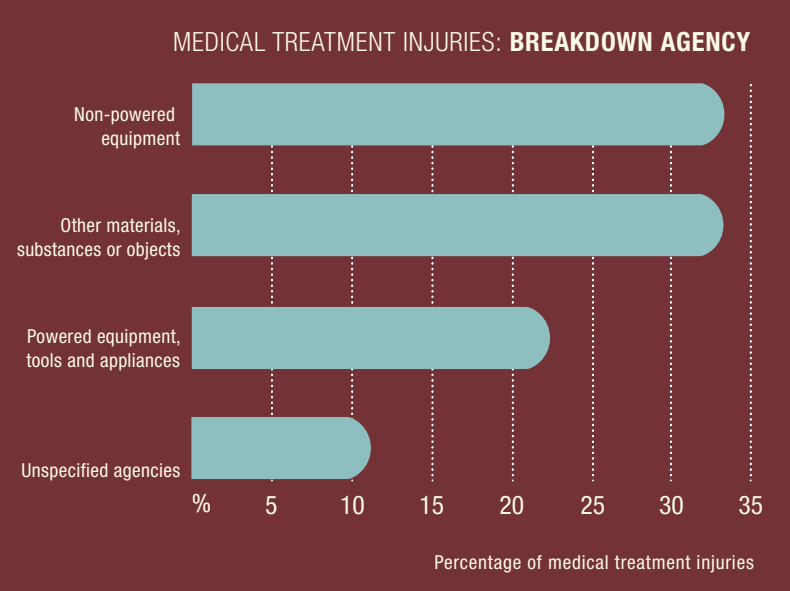
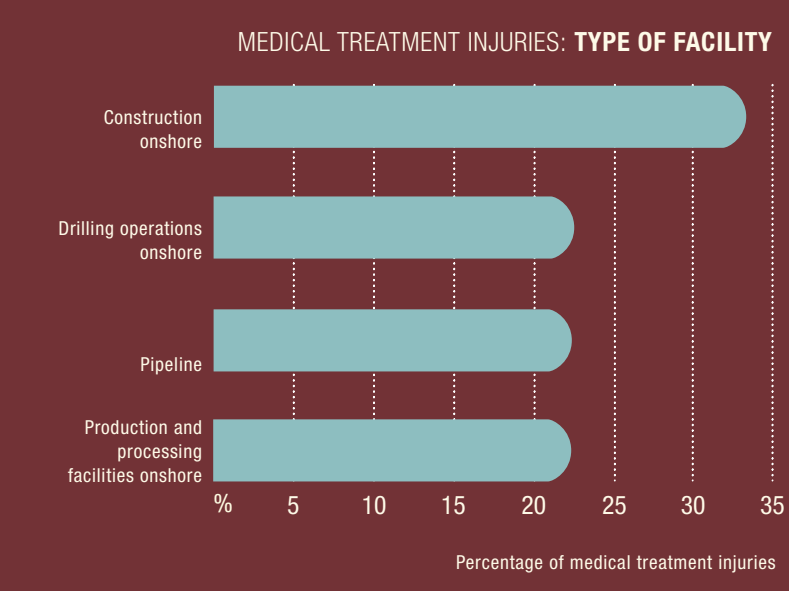
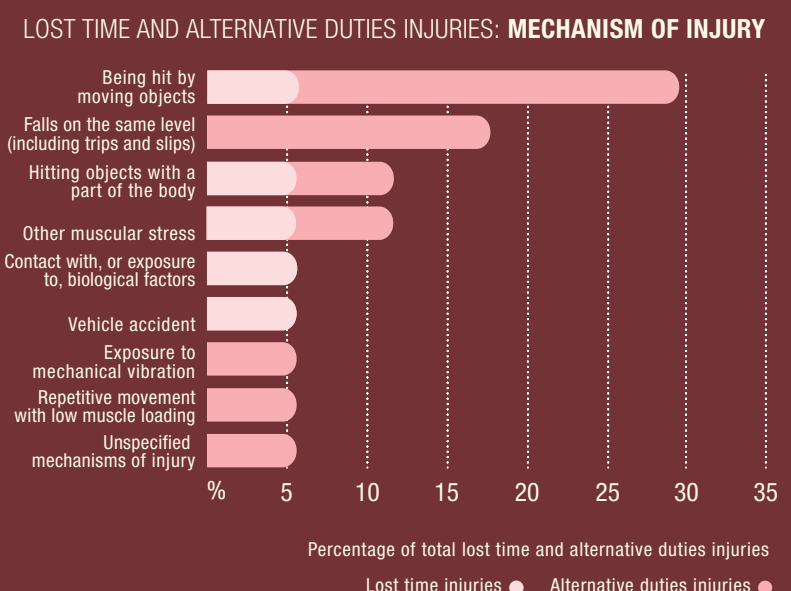
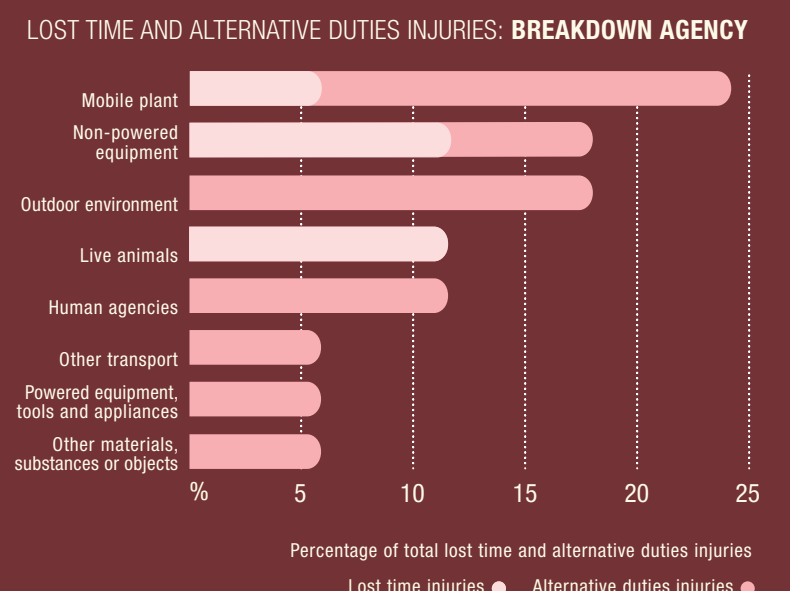
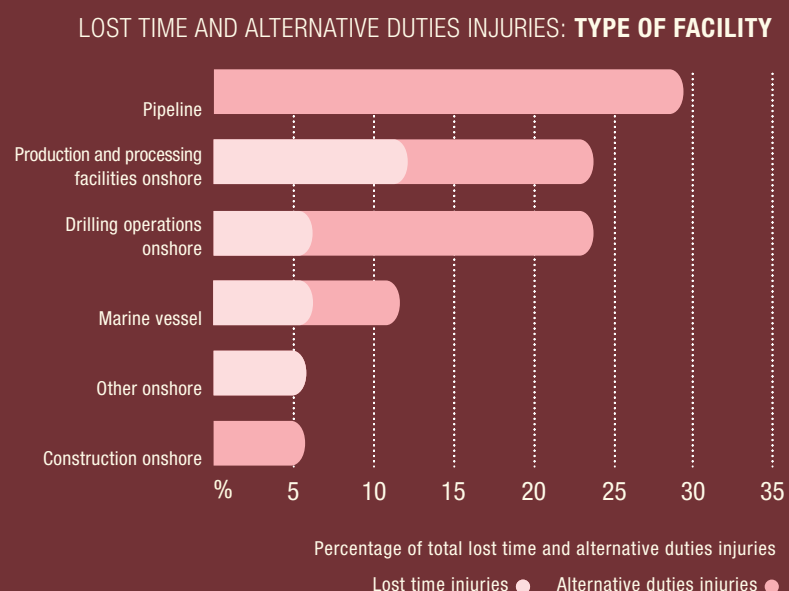


Safety Performance in the WA Petroleum Industry 2008-2009



Definitions

LOST TIME INJURY (LTI)

A lost time injury (LTI) is a work injury that results in an absence from work for at least one full day or shift any time after the day or shift on which the injury occurred.

ALTERNATIVE DUTIES INJURY (ADI)

An alternative duties injury is a work injury, which is not an LTI, that results in the injured person being unable to fully perform his or her ordinary occupation (regular job) any time after the day or shift on which the injury occurred, and where either alternative or light duties are performed.

MEDICAL TREATMENT INJURY (MTI)

A medical treatment injury (MTI) is a work injury that requires treatment beyond normal first aid but is not a lost time injury or an alternative duties injury.

LOST TIME INJURY FREQUENCY RATE (LTIFR)

The number of lost time injuries per million hours worked.

ALTERNATIVE DUTIES INJURY FREQUENCY RATE (ADIFR)

The number of alternative duties injuries per million hours worked.

MEDICAL TREATMENT INJURY FREQUENCY RATE (MTIFR)

The number of medical treatment injuries per million hours worked.

Statistical summary

There were no fatal accidents during 2008-09.

There were 5 LTIs, 12 ADIs and 9 MTIs reported for 2008-09.

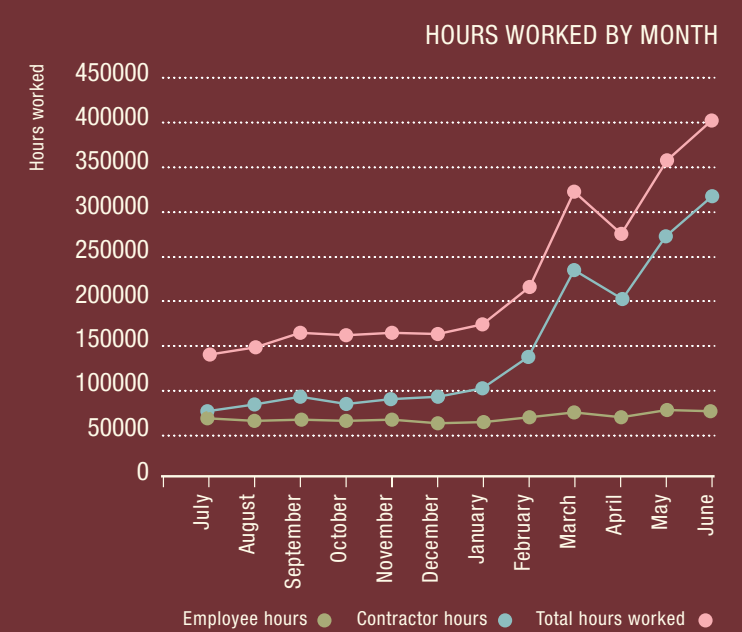
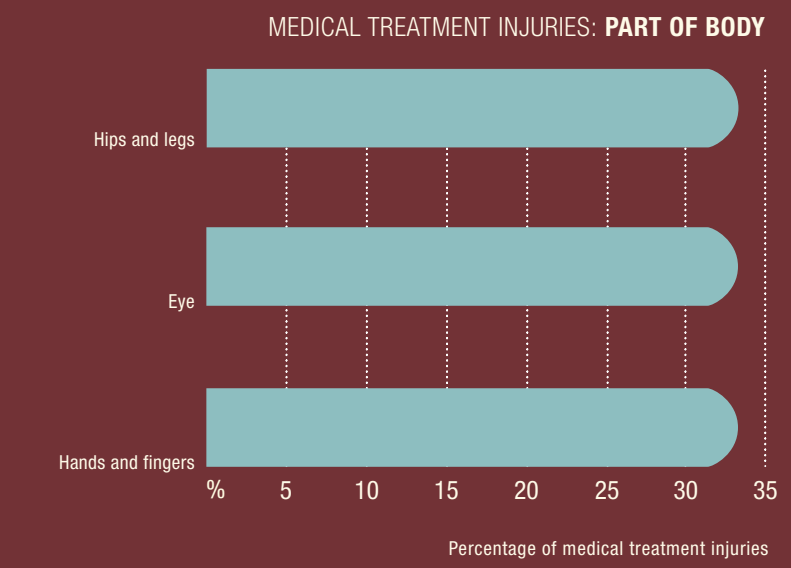
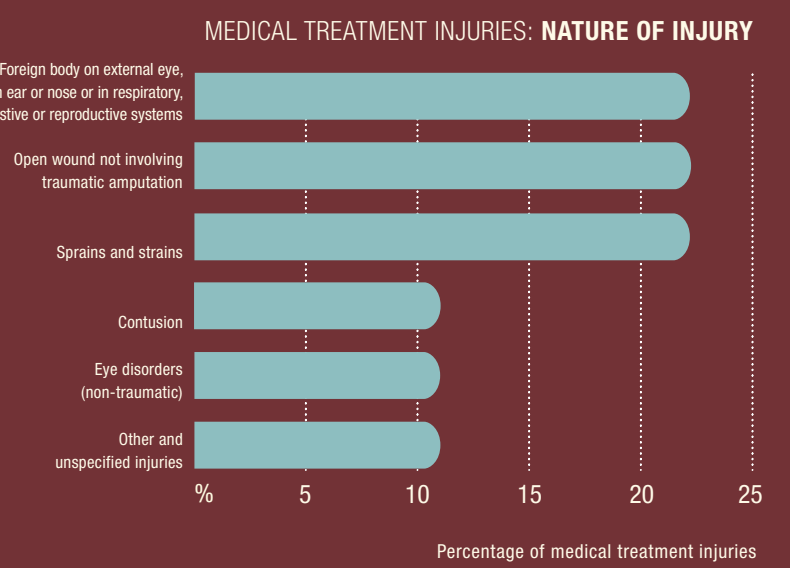
The LTIFR was 1.9 during 2008-09.

The ADIFR was 4.5 during 2008-09.

The MTIFR was 3.4 during 2008-09.

A total of 2.67 million hours were worked during 2008-09, consisting of 0.85 million hours worked by employees and 1.82 million hours worked by contractors.

An additional 0.02 million hours were reported as being worked by marine crews during 2008-09.
